Cup Tournament Rules & Regulations
<p>Bye: No BYEs this year.</p> <p>Game Durations: All games are 2 * 30 mins with a 5 minute half-time switch.</p> <p>Game Winners: Games in the Cup Qualifying Stage may end in a tie. Games in the Cup knock-Out Stage must have a winner. In case of a tie at end of regular game, the winner will be determined by Kicks from the Penalty mark, best out of 5.</p> <p>Group Rankings: Group ranking is based on accumulated points (3 for a win, 1 for a tie, 0 for a loss). In case two or more teams are tied, the following tie breaker shall be used: 1. head-to-head in Group Stage, 2. Most goals for, 3. least goals against, 4. highest goal differential, 5. standing in league, 6. coin toss.</p> <p>Wildcards: No Wildcards are used this year (the best second bests in group play. In case of a tie, tiebreakers above are used except for number 1).</p>
Referees & Tournament Discipline:
<p>Cautions and dismissals received during the tournament will be addressed prior to a player's next scheduled game. In no case can a player who was dismissed from a game play then next scheduled match. The player's team is responsible for settling the resulting fine on the spot or will forfeit all remaining games.</p>

Cup Tournament Special Rules
<p>1. The "Cobras Policy" is in effect: Teams must check in their players at the tournament desk on Saturday 30 mins before start of their first game. They must produce photo ID. Accepted photo ID is driver's license or passport. Player MUST be on game roster approved by Club AND registered with the OSA as a player of the MSA.</p> <p>1.2 Players will receive snug-fitting wrist bands, which they must not remove until end of tournament. A player without a wrist band is considered an illegal player, which will lead to a team forfeiting the match.</p> <p>1.3 Replacement wristbands, with proper ID, cost \$5 cash.</p> <p>2. The games will start on time (referee will start the clock on scheduled start times). Teams have 10 minutes from scheduled start time to field the minimum number of required players (7), or they forfeit the game (and receive a 0-3 loss). A team that has forfeited a match will NOT qualify for the knock-out stage.</p> <p>3. Any outstanding administrative and disciplinary fines must be paid to the Club by September 3rd or the team will not be allowed to play. It is the responsibility of the team managers to settle a team's account.</p> <p>4. Cautions and dismissals received during the league play carry into the tournament. Any fines/disciplinary actions received as a result of tournament play carry over to the MSA Indoor Soccer season OR the next MSA Outdoor Soccer season, depending on offending players' enrolment.</p>
